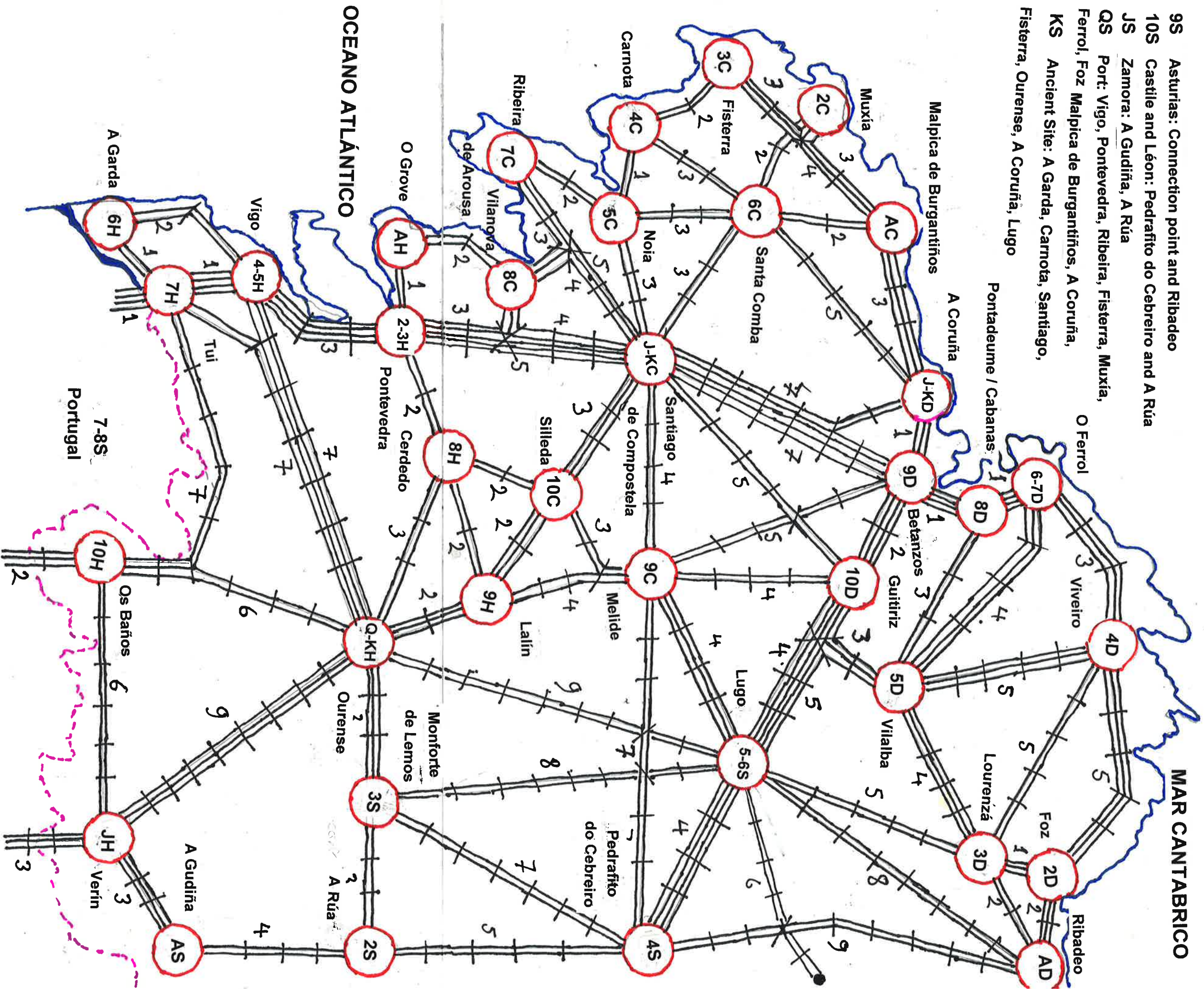

### BUS BOSS GALICIA MAP

Galicia is an autonomous community of Spain located in the Northwest corner of the Iberian Peninsula. It is made up of the four provinces of A Coruña, Lugo, Ourense and Pontevedra with a border to Portugal in the South and with the autonomous communities of Asturias, Castile and León and Zamora to the East; to the West is the Atlantic Ocean and the Cantabrian Sea lies to the North. The interior of Galicia is characterized by a hilly landscape; mountain ranges rise to 2,000 m (6,600 ft) in the east and south. The coastal areas are mostly an alternate series of rias (submerged valleys where the sea penetrates inland) and cliffs.
