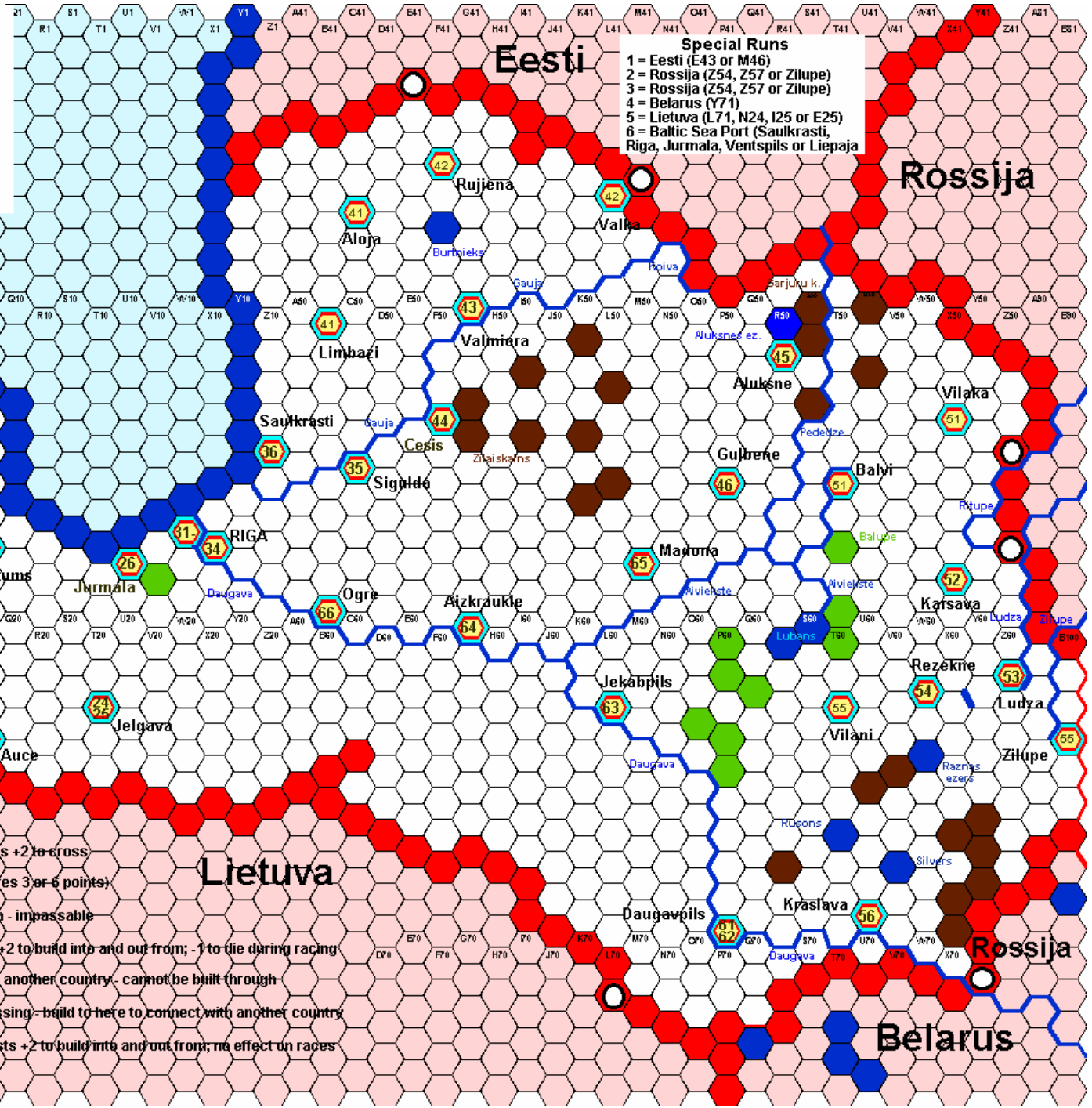


# RR - Latvia

Latvia is one of three Baltic States that became independent of Russia in the early 1990s. However, like its neighbours, Lithuania and Estonia, Latvia is still rebuilding its economy and infrastructure after years of Soviet rule. Latvia has a population of about 3 million people, 1 million of whom live in its historic capital city Riga, a former Hanseatic City and the largest city on the Baltic Sea.

This map is intended for 3 - 5 players. With 3 players, all start from Russia (Z54, Z57 or Y71); with 4 players, start towns Liepaja, Ventspils, Daugavpils and Zilupe; with 5 players, add Riga. This map was designed by Jim Reader between January and July 2003 based on a 2000 road map (including rail network). Railway Rivals was designed by David Watts and is published by Rosterne Games.



- Special Runs**
- 1 = Eesti (E43 or M46)
  - 2 = Rossija (Z54, Z57 or Zilupe)
  - 3 = Rossija (Z54, Z57 or Zilupe)
  - 4 = Belarus (Y71)
  - 5 = Lietuva (L71, N24, I25 or E25)
  - 6 = Baltic Sea Port (Saulkrasti, Riga, Jurmala, Ventspils or Liepaja)

- River - costs +2 to cross
- Town - scores 3 or 6 points
- Lake or sea - impassable
- Hill - costs +2 to build into and out from; -1 to die during racing
- Border with another country - cannot be built through
- Border crossing - build to here to connect with another country
- Marsh - costs +2 to build into and out from; no effect on races
