Standard Rules:
 4 players, two each at Sarajevo and Banja Luka. 5 players add Mostar.
 6 players, add Brčko.

Partnership Variant:
 For 3 teams of 2, 2 x Sarajevo / Banja Luka, 1x Brčko / Mostar.

- Special Runs:**
- 1: Montenegro (Župa H79, Kosman L70, Čelebići N69).
 - 2: Serbia South (Uvac S66, Visegrad, Bratunac R58).
 - 3: Serbia North (Zvornik, Janja P51, Bijeljina).
 - 4: Croatia North (Brčko, Orašje, Samac B44, Gradiška, Kozarska Dubica, Novi Grad, Velika Kladuša).
 - 5: Croatia West (Martin Brod G13, Bosansko Grahovo H17, Gorica T28).
 - 6: The Coast (Ljubuški T32, Neum X35, Ivanica [for Dubrovnik] D79).

Track cannot be built outside of the country. Destinations in italics are half-towns, 3 KMs for connecting, race to either location.

Forest hexes +1 per half hex when building, no effect on races.

'Bosnia Gauge' is still used today to identify the 760mm narrow gauge railways that became widespread in 19th and early 20th century Austria-Hungary and from there the world. Almost all those tracks were removed once a more limited standard gauge network was built after WW2.
